

Morva-Caine

Anesthetic Gel Contains Active Ingredients

Morva-Caine is a rapid-acting and long-lasting product. Anesthetic gel provides temporary relief of pain and discomfort during procedures. The gel comforts patients with ulcers, wounds or other minor mouth irritations.

Composition: PEG, Anesthetic Active Ingredients, Flavor, Food color.

This product is offered in 2 Model

Model 1: Includes a **30 ml** container of gel with the active ingredient **Benzocaine**. This model is available in 3 flavors and colors, including strawberry, blueberry, and bubble gum.

Model 2: Includes a **40 ml** container of gel with the active ingredient **Lidocaine**. This model is available in 3 flavors and colors, including strawberry, blueberry, and bubble gum.

Intended use:

For the temporary relief of occasional minor irritation and pain, associated with:

- ▶ Minor dental procedure, including local anesthesia injections, scaling or prophylaxis. It may also be used to temporarily relieve discomfort of the oral mucosa
- ▶ Sore mouth
- ▶ Minor injury of the gums
- ▶ Canker sores
- ▶ Minor irritation of the mouth or gums caused by dentures or orthodontic appliance
- ▶ Periodontal curettage
- ▶ Root planning

Advantages:

- ▶ Great tasting and pleasing to patients
- ▶ Quickly relieves patient discomfort (Start at 1-2 min)
- ▶ Maximum strength pain relief
- ▶ No systemic absorption
- ▶ Duration of effectiveness: 8-10 min

Instruction for use:

Adults and children 4 years of age and older:

- ▶ Apply (a thin film) to affected area and allow to remain in place approximately 2 minutes.
- ▶ Rinse and expectorate to clear the oral cavity of residual product.

Warning:

- ▶ Keep in cool and dry place.
- ▶ Keep out of reach of children.
- ▶ Do not use after the expiration date.
- ▶ Store in the original container at room temperature.

Precautions:

- ▶ Carefully read and understand instructions before using.
- ▶ It's necessary to use rubber-dam while working with **Morva-Caine**.
- ▶ Use eye protection, mask and gloves when using Morva-Caine
- ▶ Avoid contact with oral soft tissue, eyes or skin
- ▶ If accidental contact with soft tissues, eyes or skin occurs, immediately flush with plenty of water.
- ▶ In case of consumption drink copious amount of water.
- ▶ In case of allergies and irritation of the mucous membrane, rinse with water immediately and visit a doctor.
- ▶ Do not induce vomiting.
- ▶ Seek medical advices.
- ▶ For professional dental use only.
- ▶ Do not use in similar cases.
- ▶ At the end of the work, it is not necessary to wash with water or serum, and just remove the extra amounts from the patients mouth.
- ▶ For dental use only


Possible Side Effects:

- ▶ The use of Lidocaine and Benzocaine anesthetics in dentistry does not harm the enamel, but overuse can damage the gums and cheeks.
- ▶ If consumed in excess, it can cause side effects such as dizziness, shortness of breath, burning, swelling or tenderness of the gums and skin, itching and hives.
- ▶ In case of any side effects, refer to the medical center.

Contraindication:

- ▶ The safety and efficacy of Lidocaine and Benzocaine in children under 4 years have not been established.
- ▶ For people over 4 years old, do not repeat more than every 6 hours.
- ▶ Morva-caine is usually a safe drug if used according to the instructions.
- ▶ In case of excessive use, it has side effects (study the side effects section).
- ▶ The use of Lidocaine and Benzocaine in this dose is considered safe during pregnancy and lactation.
- ▶ Using this product topically for the gums does not cause disorders and interference with other drugs.
- ▶ Do not use in patients with drug allergies to Lidocaine, Benzocaine and anesthetics and other chemicals and ingredients.

This product is not contraindicated for the elderly, certain diseases and children over 4 years.
